

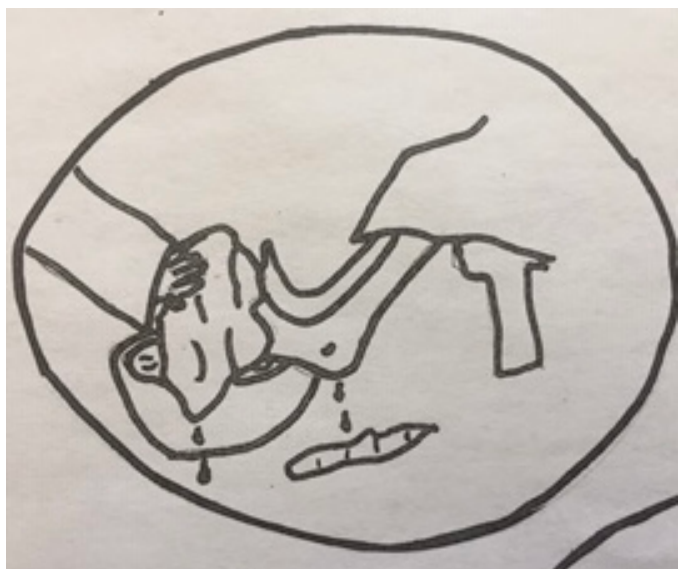
THURSDAY IN THE HOLY WEEK
